1 Miller Lite *Wisconsin* ABV 4.2% Pale Lager

2 Bell's Oberon *Weizen Michigan* ABV 5.8%

An American Wheat Ale made with European ingredients, Belgium wheat malt and Czech Saaz hops provide a spicy, fruity balance to this seasonal ale

3 Bud Light *Missouri* ABV 4.2% Light Lager

4 Fenton Staggering Bull *Pint Michigan*

ABV 7.4% Imperial Nut Brown, fuller bodied brown ale with a slight chocolate & caramel undertone and a distinct nutty aftertaste

5 Bells Two Hearted *Tulip Michigan*

ABV 7% IPA style, incredibly floral aroma and a crisp finish

6 Arcadia Starboard Stout *Pint Michigan*

ABV 5.6% Irish Oat Malt Stout, deep black in color, it has a robust yet well balanced chocolaty roasted malt character and a creamy mouthfeel

7 Avery White Rascal *Snifter Colorado*

ABV 5.6% Belgian Ale, spiced with coriander and Curacao orange peel, a refreshingly fruity thirst quencher

8 Southampton Imperial Porter *Pint New York*

ABV 7.2% a strong, dark brew. rich and flavorful with upfront notes of chocolate, caramel and toffee

9 New Holland Night Tripper *Snifter Michigan*

ABV 10.8% Imperial Stout, dark in color, abundance of roasted malts with flaked barley

10 New Holland Full Circle *Pint Michigan*

ABV 4.9% Kolsch, smooth single malt, single hop, light in body but rich in taste & character

11 Northville Winery Hard Cider *Lager Michigan*

ABV 6.5% Hard Cider

12 Arbor Brewing Co Buzz Saw *Tulip Michigan*

ABV 7.5% American Pale Ale, hops take center stage & hit you with floral notes, full bodied & citrusy

13 Shorts Yosemite Scooter *Tulip Michigan*

ABV 5.5% American Pale Ale Lighter bodied with flavors of citrus fruit with a mild earthiness

14 Arcadia London Porter *Snifter Michigan*

ABV 7.2% imperial/strong Porter, a complex and full bodied beer

15 Anderson Valley El Steinber *Pint California* ABV 5% Euro Dark Lager, nose of toasted chocolate and malt, taste is more toasted malts, well balanced body
